

The requirement


The artist collective *Keiken + George Jasper Stone* requested the glossy Harlequin Hi-Shine vinyl floor for a three channel installation called *Feel My Metaverse*. The artists had used the same floor previously and liked the mirror effect it created.



The solution

The floor of an 85m² large exhibition room was entirely covered with silver **Harlequin Hi-Shine** vinyl in order to create a reflective floor surface. The Harlequin Hi-Shine flooring was simply unrolled and stuck to the floor using double sided Harlequin tape. Thanks to this temporary installation method, the flooring can be reused.

Harlequin Hi-Shine is a glossy vinyl floor popular for concert tours, exhibitions, productions and display. It is available in many colours, including metallic silver and gold for that stunning mirror effect.
